Executive Summary

Introduction

The People's Party New Zealand Incorporated (PPNZ Inc.) is a political party founded by **Mr. Alani Fisher Taione** to provide principled, people-centred representation within Aotearoa New Zealand's democratic system. The Party exists to ensure that the voices, needs, and aspirations of everyday New Zealanders are reflected in public policy and political leadership.

Established in accordance with the **Electoral Act 1993**, the **Incorporated Societies Act 2022**, and governed by its Constitution and By-Laws, PPNZ Inc. is committed to lawful, transparent, and accountable political participation. The Party is founded on the belief that political authority derives from the people and must be exercised in service to them.

Mission and Core Values

Mission

The mission of the People's Party New Zealand is to build a fairer, more inclusive, and just society by empowering communities through ethical leadership, democratic participation, and policies grounded in human dignity.

Core Values

The Party is guided by the following core values:

- **Equality** - Equal rights, opportunity, and treatment for all New Zealanders.
- **Integrity** - Transparency, accountability, and ethical leadership at all levels.
- **Justice** - Fairness, human rights protection, and social responsibility.
- **Community** - Collective wellbeing, social cohesion, and shared responsibility.
- **Sustainability** - Stewardship of the environment for future generations.
- **Democracy** - Respect for democratic institutions and people-powered governance.

Governance and Legal Structure

The People's Party New Zealand Incorporated is governed by a **Governing Board**, supported by officers and committees operating under the Party's Constitution and By-Laws.

Founder and President

- **Mr. Alani Fisher Taione**, as Founder, holds the office of **President for life**, unless he voluntarily resigns or upon his passing.
- The President provides strategic leadership, chairs the Governing Board, and safeguards the Party's founding principles, vision, and discipline.

Governing Board and Officers

The governance structure includes:

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- President
- Vice President
- Party Leader and Deputy Party Leader
- Secretary General and Assistant Secretary
- Treasurer and Assistant Treasurer
- Auditor
- Lawyer

All officers are subject to statutory duties, fiduciary obligations, and internal accountability mechanisms.

Membership and Democratic Participation

Membership is open to eligible individuals who support the Party's values and comply with its rules.

Members may:

- Participate in Party meetings, campaigns, and policy development.
- Vote at Party Conferences (subject to eligibility).
- Stand for Party office or selection as candidates.
- Contribute to the growth and credibility of the Party.

Membership administration complies fully with Electoral Commission requirements.

Party Conference and Internal Democracy

The Party holds an **Annual Party Conference**, which serves as the principal decision-making forum. The Conference:

- Adopts and reviews Party policy.
- Elects or confirms Board positions.
- Receives financial and governance reports.
- Sets strategic priorities.

Special General Meetings may be convened when required.

Parliamentary Representation and Caucus

Where the People's Party New Zealand has representation in the House of Representatives, all elected Members of Parliament shall form the **Party Caucus**, operating in accordance with the Constitution.

The **Caucus**:

- Serves as the Party's parliamentary decision-making body.
- Is chaired by the Party Leader, or Deputy Party Leader in their absence.
- Operates under the principle of **collective responsibility**, requiring Members to support agreed Caucus decisions publicly.
- Coordinates parliamentary strategy, legislation, debates, select committee participation, and voting discipline.
- Maintains strict confidentiality of its proceedings.
- May appoint a Whip to manage attendance and parliamentary organisation.
- Remains accountable to Party policy and governance structures, while operating autonomously in parliamentary matters.

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The Caucus does not have authority to amend Party policy independently of the processes set out in the Constitution.

Core Objectives and Policy Focus Areas

The People's Party New Zealand focuses on practical, people-centred outcomes, including:

1. **Economic Justice** – Fair wages, secure employment, and equitable economic growth.
2. **Healthcare and Wellbeing** – Accessible healthcare, mental health support, and health equity.
3. **Education** – Inclusive, high-quality education for all.
4. **Environmental Sustainability** – Climate responsibility, renewable energy, and biodiversity protection.
5. **Social Welfare and Inclusion** – Housing affordability, poverty reduction, and community support.
6. **Indigenous and Treaty Commitments** – Upholding **Te Tiriti o Waitangi** and recognising Māori as tangata whenua.
