

People's Party New Zealand Immigration Policy

The People's Party New Zealand (PPNZ) is committed to implementing a fair, balanced, and pragmatic immigration policy that prioritizes the needs of New Zealanders while providing opportunities for those seeking to contribute to our nation. Our key policies include:

1. Amnesty for Overstayers

- The PPNZ will grant **amnesty** to overstayers currently residing in New Zealand, allowing them to obtain a **5-year work permit** before becoming eligible to apply for **Permanent Residency (PR)** in New Zealand, subject to specific conditions.

2. Trans-Pacific Visa for Pacific Islanders

- A **Trans-Pacific Visa** will be introduced, enabling individuals from Pacific nations to work in New Zealand for **five years** before becoming eligible to apply for **Permanent Residency (PR)**, subject to conditions.

3. Prioritizing New Zealand's Needs

- PPNZ will ensure that New Zealand's **domestic interests and affairs** are prioritized before extending resources to assist other nations.

4. Refugee Screening

- All refugees will undergo rigorous **criminal and security screenings** to ensure that no individuals with criminal or terrorist affiliations are allowed entry into New Zealand.

5. Validation of Overseas Qualifications

- Overseas qualifications will be **verified and reassessed** within a reasonable timeframe to ensure they meet New Zealand's professional and safety standards, particularly for specialized fields such as medicine, nursing, aviation, and engineering.
