

Party Policy on the Treaty of Waitangi

The People's Party New Zealand is committed to honouring the Treaty of Waitangi as agreed upon by Captain William Hobson and the 43–46 Māori Rangatira at Waitangi Marae on 6 February 1840.

Under a People's Party NZ government, we will:

- Formally **apologize on behalf of the Crown** for historical injustices.
- Recognize and address the grievances arising from lands, including the seabed, that were unjustly taken from Māori communities.
- Work toward **fair compensation** for Māori to restore equity and justice for the losses endured.

Our Party acknowledges the enduring significance of the Treaty of Waitangi as the founding document of Aotearoa New Zealand, and we are dedicated to fostering a future built on respect, partnership, and meaningful reconciliation.
